It duly appearing to the court that the land description set forth in the claim and statement and proof of claimant of H. H. Gilbert filed and on record with the Clerk of the Court and described as Section 4. Township 1 South of Range 32, E.W.M. is a true description and Range of said lands, and

It further appearing to the court that the Range as given in the description of the lands listed under the name of H. H. Cilbert, appropriator, at page 57 of the Findings of Fact and at page \_\_\_\_\_ of the decree in this matter, and at page 277 of Folume A of Water Right Certificate Book as "North" of Range 32" is incorrect, and

It further appearing to the court that the mistake is evident on the fact of the record, and

The court being now fully advised in the premises,

It is therefore hereby ORDERED that the true and correct description of the lands listed under the name of H. H. Gilbert, appropriator at page 57 of the Findings of Fact, which Findings of Fact were filed in this matter with the Clerk of this court on the 9th day of September, 1916, and also at page 203 of the decree entered herein on September 9, 1916, and also at page 277 of Voluma A of the Water Right Certificate Book filed herein, is "south of Range 32, and that the full, true and correct Section, Township and Range of the said lands is Section 4, Township 1, South of Range 32, E.W.M.

It is further ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court forthwith correct said findings of fact, decree and Water Right Certificate Book filed herein, so that the true and correct description shall appear in each of said instruments in accordance with this order.

That the County Clerk of Umatilla County, Oregon, be and she is hereby directed to enter upon said original a notation that the same is amended as provided by this decree.

That the defendant Chas. E. Stricklin as State Engineer and watermaster be and he is hereby ordered and directed to correct the records in his office to conform to and in accordance with this decree and it is further directed that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to the said Daniel Shaw erroneously describing his lands as being located in Section 14 and Section 28, Township 1 North, Range 32, E. W. M., be cancelled and that he cause a new certificate of water right to be issued covering the lands to which water right was adjudicated to the said Daniel Shaw as located in Section 14 and that the new certificate eliminate therefrom all lands in Section 28 and that there be inserted in such new certificate the lands in Section 23 Township 1 North, Range 32, E. W. M., as hereinabove in this decree designated.

THIS MATTER coming on now regularly to be heard for decree herein, plaintiff appearing by Messis. Raley, Kilkenny & Raley, his attorneys, and the defendant Chas.

E. Stricklin as State Engineer of the State of Oregon and as watermaster having appeared herein by answer admitting the allegations of plaintiff's complaint and joining in the prayer of plaintiff's complaint and the other defendants not appearing and default having heretofore been entered against them and each of them and that none of the parties hereto have requested findings of fact or conclusions of law.

It is therefore hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

That the decree rendered in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon in the proceeding therein pending entitled "In the matter of the determination of the relative rights of the various claimers to the waters of the Umatilla River and its tributaries, a tributary of the Columbia River in Umatilla County, Oregon" by eliminating therefrom the award and adjudication to Daniel Shaw of the right to the use of waters of McKay Creek by eliminating therefrom the following language:

"40 acres in the NEt of the NEt;

7 acres in the NWt of the NEt, 8 acres in the SWt of the NEt, 30 acres in the SEt of the NEt, Section 28, in Township 1 North, Range 32, E., W. M."

and that said decree be further amended by inserting in lieu thereof in said decree and at the place where said language is eliminated the following language, to-wit:

"40 acres in the NEt of the NEt, 7 acres in the NWt of the NEt, 8 acres in the SWt of the NEt, 30 acres in the SEt of the SEt Section 23, in Township 1 North, Range 32 E., W. M."

THIS MATTER coming on to be heard on the Motion of Clark Bolin and Grace Bolin, husband and wife, for an Order Nunc Pro Tunc correcting Findings 34 of the Final Decree, dated September 9, 1916, on the grounds of clerical error,

AND IT APPEARING TO THE COURT from the records and files herein and the Affidavit of Clark Bolin and Grace Bolin, husband and wife, that they are the successors in interest of Chris Roberts, deceased, and that the said Chris Roberts on the 12th day of May, 1910, submitted a Proof of Claimant upon the following described real property, to-wit:

The East Half of the Northwest Quarter and the Northwest Quarter of. the Southwest Quarter of Section 36, Township 3 Morth, Hange 29 E.W.M...

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that the said Chris Roberts made an error in said description for he did not own the said Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said section but in truth, and in fact owned the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said section 36,

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that in and by said Proof of Claim the said Chris Roberts stated he was irrigating or capable of irrigating 25 acres of the ground described and that twelve of the acres were situated in the East Half of the Northwest Quarter and two acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of said section 36, and that there is a distinction between "Vested" and "Inchoate" water rights and that by clerical error the inchoate rights were granted in section 26, Township 3 North, Range 29 EaW. M.,

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that the said Chris Roberts had died prior to the hearing on the said water rights and that facts were stipulated and that testimony went only to the date of priority and the use of the water for irrigation and that the error of description was not detected and through inadvertence and clerical error the Final Decree did not properly describe the lands involved and the court being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Final Decree entered by the Court on the 9th day of September, 1916, in the above entitled matter be, and the same hereby is corrected in the following particulars, to-wit, that the inchoate rights decreed to Chris Roberts shall be described as follows:

11 acres in the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 29 E.W.M.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order correcting the Final Decree be entered Nunc Pro Tunc to appear of record as of the 9th day of September, 1916, that being the date when said Final Decree was originally made and entered.

SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER OF DETERMINATION

Now at this time the above entitled matter coming before the State Engineer for consideration and for making supplemental findings as to the completion of inchoate rights to the use of the waters of Umatilla River as allowed by Decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, entered on September 9, 1916, hereinafter referred to as the Umatilla River Decree; and it appearing that the time for the completion of each and all of said inchoate rights, as set by said Umatilla River Decree and as subsequently extended from time to time by orders of the State Engineer has expired; that after due notice to the water users interested herein the State Engineer caused the proofs and evidence to be taken showing the extent of the completion of such rights in accordance with said decree; that a field survey of the lands reclaimed and irrigated in completion of said inchoate rights was made during the year 1949 under the direction of the State Engineer and a map prepared from said field survey, hereinafter referred to as the State Engineer's map; that the sworn statements of various water users, or their successors in interest, who were allowed inchoate rights by said Umatilla River Decree, relative to the completion of their rights, have been taken and filed as a part of this record; and the State Engineer now being fully advised in the premises makes the following Supplemental Findings of Fact and Order of Determination:

-1-

That under the provisions of paragraph 34 of said Umatilla River Decree, certain claimants to the use of the waters of Umatilla River who had not completed their appropriations, were granted inchoate or conditional rights thereto and were allowed until January 1, 1918, in certain cases and until January 1, 1920, in other cases, to complete such inchoate appropriations. It appears that, due to economic and other conditions, many of such appropriators were unable to complete their appropriations within the time limits set by the Umatilla River Decree, and that upon proper application being made therefor, such time limits were extended from time to time by Order of the State Engineer.

That any of the persons, firms, associations and corporations and their successors in interest, listed under paragraph 2, herein, who may own lands not covered by the above listed Proofs of Appropriation filed in the office of the State Engineer, and who have failed and neglected to appear in this proceeding or to submit or offer any proof herein, and any of the foregoing persons, firms, associations and corporations whose name does not appear in the ensuing sections of these findings, is hereby declared to be in default and is deemed to have forfeited all rights to the use of the waters herein involved under the inchoate rights set out in the Umatilla River Decree.

- 4 -

That at the time of the original proceeding, many of the appropriators had not completed their appropriations and reclaimed and irrigated all of the land susceptable of being reclaimed and irrigated, as contemplated, and in the Umatilla River Decree, were allowed completed or vested rights for the acreage then found to be completely reclaimed and irrigated, and inchoate or conditional rights for the remaining acreage deemed to be susceptable of reclamation and irrigation but not at that time completed and were allowed further time for the completion of their contemplated appropriations.

That during the ensuing years many acres of land lying along the Umatilla River and within its flood plane, have been washed away and destroyed for agricultural purposes, including some of the land for which vested rights were allowed in the Umatilla River Decree. That in the survey of the lands, made under the direction of the State Engineer during the year 1949, all of the land which was found to be irrigated, was included, as shown on the map prepared from said survey, entitled "Adjudication Survey of Lands allowed an inchoate water right from Umatilla River and its Tributaries" and, by reference as the "State Engineer's map" made a part of the record herein.

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It appears that in some instances claimants in this proceeding are the proprietors of lands which were found to be irrigated and so classified by the State Engineer, but which lands were not allowed a water right by the Umatilla River Decree, and other lands which were allowed an inchoate right under said decree but were found to be not irrigated. In all such cases, where such lands are now in on contiguous ownership or farm unit, claimant will be allowed a completed right herein to the extent of the number of acres of land classified by the State Engineer as irrigated in completion of the inchoate right allowed by said decree, but not to exceed the total number of acres allowed an inchoate right in said decree, appurtenant to the subdivisions or fraction thereof embodied in claimant's farm unit.

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That in the ensuing paragraphs each of the Proofs of Appropriation submitted by the various claimants or their successors in interest, under the inchoate right set forth in paragraph 34 of the Umatilla River Decree, is treated and the rights herein allowed are determined and are more particularly set out and described in the tabulation of water rights under paragraph 27 herein.

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## Allen Ditch Company

Proof of Appropriation submitted by the Allen Ditch Company covering all of the lands served by its distribution system, asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 1141.9 acres of land located in Sections 7, 8, 16, 17 and 18, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

Of this amount 920.0 acres were allowed a vested right by the Umatilla River Decree, leaving 221.9 acres being claimed as inchoate acreage for which their appropriation is claimed to be completed. The Umatilla River Decree allowed a total of 202.0 acres of inchoate right under the original claim of the Allen Ditch Company.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated in the government sub-divisions for which a claim is asserted herein, within the apparent boundary of the Allen Ditch Company, a total of 958.0 acres. Of this total irrigated acreage, 825.9 acres has a vested right under the decree.

The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the lands, number of acres allowed vested and inchoate rights by the Umatilla River Decree, total number of acres shown as irrigated on the State Engineer's map, total acreage for which a claim is asserted in the proof, vested acreage actually irrigated, inchoate acreage actually irrigated and allowed a completed right in this proceeding.

It appears that the Allen Ditch Company has beneficially irrigated a total of 132.1 acres of land in completion of the incheate rights allowed by the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Allen Canal, with a date of priority of 1900, for the irrigation of a total of 132.1 acres of land, said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and number of acres as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

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## Andrews Bros. (Fred Andrews)

Proof of Appropriation and amendment thereto, filed herein by Fred Andrews on behalf of Andrews Bros., asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 96.5 acres of land as shown on the State Engineer's map, which claimant accepts as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

Said lands are described as: 30.0 acres in the NELNWL, 11.0 acres in the NWLNWL, 33.0 acres in the SWLNWL, 17.8 acres in the SELNWL and 4.7 acres in the ELNELSWL, Section 2, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M. Claimant did not state the name of the ditch serving said lands.

The irrigated land in said NW2NW2 and SW2NW2 is included in the proof of the Westland Irrigation District and will be treated under the findings relative to said proof.

In the Unatilla River Decree, incheate rights were allowed in the name of Will Moore for 37.0 acres in the NE2NW1, said Section 2, through the Pioneer-Courtney Canal with a date of priority of 1900, and for 105.0 acres within said Section 2, through the Hinkle Ditch, (now for called the Westland Canal), in the name of the Westland and Irrigation Co., (now the Westland Irrigation District), with a date of priority of March 14, 1903.

It appears that for many years past said lands have been irrigated through the Westland Canal; that the waters delivered through the Pioneer-Courtney Canal and the Westland Canal are all diverted from the Umatilla River through one diversion structure, located at a point approximately 750 feet north and 100 feet east of the center of Section 21, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.; and that claimant has an agreement with the Westland Irrigation District for delivery of mater through the Westland Canal for the irrigation of said lands.

A right is allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Westland Canal, for the irrigation of 30,0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, with a date of priority of 1900, and for 17.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and 4.7 acres in the E $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 2, with a date of priority of March 14, 1903, all lands being within T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

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### Brownell Ditch Company

Proof of Appropriation submitted by the Brownell Ditch Company covering the lands served by the Brownell Ditch, asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 242.1339 acres within Sections 9, 16 and 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.H.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the government legal subdivisions in which the lands herein claimed are located, a total of 166.7 acres of which amount 43.7 acres were allowed vested rights under the Umatilla River Decree.

The following tabulation shows the name of landowner as set out in the proof, section and subdivision in which land is located, number of acres allowed vested right in Umatilla River Decree, number of acres for which a claim is asserted in the proof and number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated.

It is noted from the above tabulation that under some ownerships, more acreage is claimed in the proof as irrigated than is shown classified by the State Engineer as irrigated. Each of said claims will be treated independently.

## Gordon E. Eisel

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Gordon E. Disel asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 15.81 acres in the SWANWA, Section 16 and the SEANE4, Section 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the tract of land apparently owned by Gordon E. Eisel, as recorded in Volume 175, page 520, Deed Records of Umatilla County, 9.5 acres in the SWANWA, said Section 16 and 5.0 acres in the SEANEA, said Section 17. It appears that all of the land within the Eisel Tract is irrigated except an area of approximately 1.5 acres in the SE portion of the tract, adjacent to the Brownell Ditch, which area was being used as a storage stockpile for crushed rock.

acres in the SEANEA, Section 17, T. 5 No., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

## Scott-Jones Company

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Scott-Jones Co. asserts a claim for the irrigation of 5.75 acres in the SWaNNA, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the tract of land apparently owned by Scott-Jones Co., as recorded in Volume 183, page 92, Deed Records of Umatilla County, 3.0 acres in said Swinnit.

It appears that all of said tract was not irrigated, a narrow strip around the northerly edge was waste land and a small area at the southwest corner was included in the crushed-rock stockpile yard mentioned in the findings relative to the Gordon E. Eisel Tract.

A right is allowed under the name of Scott-Jones Co. for the irrigation of 3.0 acres in the SWANWA, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

## Charles Fiebke

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Charles Fiebke asserts a claim for the irrigation of 21.0 acres in the SW4NW4, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the tract of land apparently owned by Charles Fiebke, as recorded in Volume 181, page 625, Deed Records of Umatilla County, 0.9 acre in the  $SW_1^1WW_{14}^2$ , Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

It appears from said recorded description that the Fiebke tract is a rectangular area approximately 200 feet on each side, containing 0.91 acre of land. The State Engineer's map shows said tract as irrigated.

A right is allowed in the name of Charles Fiebke for the irrigation of 0.9 acre within the SW2NW2, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

### George M. Sharp

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of George M. Sharp asserts a claim for the irrigation of 4.76 acres in the SWANWA, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the tract apparently owned by George M. Sharp, as recorded in Volume 145, page 351, Deed Records of Umatilla County, 3.5 acres within said SWANWA, Section 16. It is noted from the recorded property description, that the tract is bounded on the south by the Brownell Ditch right-of-way line and on the east by the east line of the SWANWA, said Section 16, and that said description excepts "any and all county road right-of-way." A forty-foot county road along said east line of the SWANWA and a distribution lateral ditch paralleling the Brownell Ditch reduce the irrigated area of the tract, but, from a careful recomputation, it appears that approximately 4.0 acres may be classified as irrigated land.

A right is allowed in the name of George M. Sharp for the irrigation of 4.0 acres in the SW4NW4, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

## Ben Shepler

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Ben Shepler asserts a claim for the irrigation of 32.17 acres within the SELSEL, Section 9 and the NAME, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the tracts of land apparently owned by Ben Shepler, as recorded in Volume 174, page 442 and Volume 186, page 270, Deed Records of Umatilla County, a total of 12.8 acres. It appears that, from the bearings and distances designated in said recorded descriptions, the location of the section line between Sections 9 and 16 is shown on the State Engineer's map approximately 60 feet south of its true location. This would not alter the total acreage classified as irrigated but would change the apportionment of said total within the respective government subdivisions involved. It thus appears that the irrigated acreage is as follows: 2.5 acres in the SEASEA, Section 9, 8.7 acres in the NEANEA and 1.6 acres in the NWANEA, Section 16.

All of the land covered by said property descriptions, located north of and below the Brownell Ditch, is shown as irrigated on the State Engineer's map except an area of approximately 2.0 acres located at the extreme east end of the tract, which was occupied as a trailer park by employees on the McNary Dam construction, and a small area of approximately 0.5 acre in the southwest corner of the tract which was unimproved and in a dense stand of sage brush.

A right is allowed under the name of Ben Shepler for the irrigation of a total of 13.0 acres, being 2.5 acres in the SEASEA, Section 9, 8.8 acres in the NEANEA and 1.7 acres in the NWANEA, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

#### Gus Tonies

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Gus Tonies, asserts a claim for the irrigation of 5.75 acres within the SWASEA, Section 9, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The description of the tract of land apparently owned by Gus Tonies, as recorded in Volume 121, page 186, Deed Records of Umatilla County indicates that said tract is located adjacent to and north of the O.W.R.R.& N. Co.'s right-of-way, of which approximately 4.2 acres are located within the SWASEA, Section 9 and approximately 1.6 acres are located in the NWANEA, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

It appears from the recorded property description, that the section line between Sections 9 and 16 is shown on the State Engineer's map approximately 60 feet south of its true location.

It further appears that all of said Tonies Tract is irrigated.

A right is allowed under the name of Gus Tonies for the irrigation of 4.2 acres in the SWASEL, Section 9 and 1.6 acres in the NWANEL, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

#### Darrell Hadley

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Darrell Hadley asserts a claim for the irrigation of 13.95 acres within the SWESE, Section 9, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The Hadley tract, as shown by the description recorded in Volume 172, page 294, Deed Records of Umatilla County, contains a total area of slightly more than 14.0 acres, however a 60 foot county road right-of-way exists along the north boundary of the tract and occupies approximately 0.69 acre of the described area.

It appears, from the recorded property description of this tract that the section line between Sections 9 and 16 is shown on the State Engineer's map approximately 60 feet south of its true location and that all of the Hadley tract is located north of the O.W.R.R. & N. Co.'s north right-of-way line.

The State Engineer's map shows a total of 18.4 acres irrigated in said SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)SE\(\frac{1}{2}\), Section 9, of which amount 4.2 acres was allowed under the claim of Gus Tonies.

A right is allowed under the name of Darrell Hadley for the irrigation of 14.0 acres in the SWLSEL, Section 9, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

## Bud Knapp

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of Bud Knapp asserts a claim for the irrigation of 3.0 acres in the NWZNEZ, Section 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The Knapp tract, as shown by the description recorded in Volume 169, page 139, Deed Records of Umatilla County, is a trapezium area containing approximately 3.0 acres. The State Engineer's map shows only 0.6 acre irrigated within said tract, being a strip approximately 100 feet deep across the northerly end. The remainder of the tract was in sage and weeds and bore no evidence of having been irrigated.

A right is allowed under the name of Bud Knapp for the irrigation of 1.0 acre in the NWANEA, Section 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

## Standard Oil Company

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of the Standard Oil Company asserts a claim for the irrigation of 13.8439 acres within the NWANEL, Section 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The Standard Oil Company tract, as shown by the property description recorded in Volume 155, page 391, Deed Records of Umatilla County, is located principally in the W2NW4NE4, Section 17 but extending through Government Lot 1 of Section 8, to the high water meander line of the Columbia River.

The State Engineer's map shows no irrigated land within said tract. A lateral of the Brownell Ditch Company distribution system is located along the north right-of-way line of the O.W.R.R. & N. Co. and extends past the west boundary of the Standard Oil Company tract. At the time of the examination of the lands on September 12, 1949, it was observed that an earth dam existed across said lateral at a point approximately midway of the south boundary of said tract,

diverting the flow into a sublateral, northerly through said tract approximately 400 feet to the south line of a county road, thence easterly along said county road for a distance of approximately 1000 feet. The lateral and sub-lateral were dry at the time of the examination and, from the accumulation of debris in said laterals, it appeared that water had not been delivered therein for quite some time. The above mentioned earth dam was well sodded and appeared to have been in place for several years past.

No evidence of irrigation was observed on said Standard Oil Company tract. Representatives of the Company assert that water is being used for the irrigation of trees which have been planted to form a wind-break and also a dozen or so fruit trees. It appears that such asserted use is entirely possible and may have been overlooked at the time of the examination of the lands. It further appears that 1.0 acre of water is ample for such use.

A right is allowed under the name of the Standard Oil Company for the irrigation of 1.0 acre within the NWthEt, Section 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

Arrow Transportation Co.

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of the Arrow Transportation Co. asserts a claim for the irrigation of 2.2 acres in the NWANE2 and NE2NW2, Section 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The tract apparently owned by the Arrow Transportation Co., as shown by the property description recorded in Volume 155, page 577, Deed Records for Unatilla County, appears to be located west of and adjacent to the southwest portion of the Standard Oil Company tract and all within the NWANEA, said Section 17.

The State Engineer's map does not show any irrigated land in said tract. The area appeared to be used exclusively for truck line terminal facilities and no evidence of irrigation was observed. The lateral ditch of the Brownell Ditch Company distribution system, which may have formerly served the land in this area was obstructed by a well sodded earth dam at a point approximately 300 feet above this tract, which appeared to have been in place for many years, and the lateral below said dam was filled with debris and becoming obliterated.

The asserted right for the irrigation of 2.2 acres within the tract of land covered by this claim, hereby is denied.

### J. B. Plant

Proof of appropriation submitted under the name of J. B. Plant asserts a claim for the irrigation of 14.0 acres in the NETWH, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

The tract apparently owned by J. B. Plant as described in deed recorded in Volume 117, page 523, Deed Records for Umatilla County, consists of a rectangular plot 208.6 feet square, located adjacent to and north of the O.W.R.R. & N. Co's. north right-of-way line within the NW; NE; NW; said Section 16, containing an area of 1.0 acre. The State Engineer's map shows all of said tract as irrigated.

A right is allowed under the name of J. B. Plant for the irrigation of 1.0 acre in the NETNWA, Section 16, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The land to which this right is appurtenent is more specifically described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

It appears that of the lands allowed an inchoate right by the Umatilla River Decree in the name of the Brownell Ditch Co. a total of 168.1 acres are being beneficially irrigated in completion of such inchoate appropriation.

A right is herein allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Brownell Ditch, with a date of priority of 1903 for the irrigation of a total of 168.1 acres of land in Sections 9, 16 and 17, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M. The lands to which said right is appurtenant are more specifically set out and described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

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#### Brown's Dairy

Proof of appropriation submitted by Brown's Dairy, T. O. Brown, Agent, Box 232, Rieth, Oregon, asserts a claim for stock use and the irrigation of a total of 88.2 acres within Sections 14, 15 and 16, T. 2 N., R. 31 E., W.M. through the Barnhart Ditch diverting from the Umatilla River.

It appears that claimant herein is successor to the J. E. Smith Livestock Company under whose name certain vested and incheate rights were recognized in the Umatilla River Decree.

The following tabulation shows the pertinent data relative to this claim: name of claimant, description of land involved, number of acres allowed a vested right and number of acres allowed an incheate right by the Umatilla River Decree, total number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated, and number of acres for which a right is allowed torein.

In the Umatilla River Decree, an inchoate right was allowed under the name of the J. E. Smith Livestock Co., with a date of priority of 1902, for the irrigation of, among other lands, 17.5 acres in Section 14, 10.5 acres in Section 15 and 51.5 acres in Section 16, T. 2 N., R. 31 E., W.M. Said lands were to be served through the Smith ditch by direct diversion from the Umatilla River.

It appears that the ditch, then known as the Smith Ditch, is the same diversion ditch as is, in this proof, called the Barnhart Ditch, diverting from the right side of the Umatilla River within the SERWY. Section 14, T. 2 N., R. 31 E., W.M.

It further appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated a total of 23.65 acres of land in completion of the incheate right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is herein allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Barnhart Ditch, with a date of priority of 1902, for the irrigation of 23.65 acres in Sections 14, 15 and 16, T. 2 N., R. 31 E., W.M. Said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and mumber of acres as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

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### Courtney Irrigation Co.

In the Umatilla River Decree inchoate rights were allowed the Courtney Irrigation Co. under the names of the individual landowners for a total of 1078.0 acres, and vested rights upon certain of the same lands to the extent of a total of 517.0 acres.

In this proceeding Statements and Proofs of Claim covering the lands now served by the Courtney Irrigation Company have been filled by the individual landowners and each will be treated separately.

#### Frank J. Correa, Jr.

Proof of Appropriation filed herein by Frank J. Correa, Jr. asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 105.4 acres of land located in the approximate south three-quarters of the SWA, Section 12, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M., through the Courtney Canal. Said acreage is as shown to be irrigated on the State Engineer's map which claimant accepts as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

Said lands were allowed vested and inchoate rights in the Umatilla River Decree under the Courtney Irrigation Company, in the name of C. J. Smith. Since claimant owns only the south one-half of the NE4SW4 and NW4SW4, one-half of the vested and inchoate rights allowed appurtenant to said subdivisions will be credited thereto.

The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the lands for which a right is asserted in the proof, number of acres allowed vested and incheate by the Umatilla River Decree, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed a completed right in this proceeding.

It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated a total of 59.9 acres of land in completion of the incheste right allowed in the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is herein allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Courtney Canal, for the irrigation of 59.9 acres of land, with a priority of 1900, said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and number of acres as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

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#### J. M. Kelso

Proof of appropriation filed herein by J. M. Eelso asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 229.1 acres of land as shown to be irrigated on the State Engineer's map which claimant accepts as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

Claimant's land lies in two separate units and from the legal descriptions of the land submitted with the proof, it appears that claimant owns the NWA and N2N2SWA of Section 12, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M. as one unit, and the W2NELNWA, except that portion in the NE corner lying north of the slough, the SEANWA, the east approximately 152 feet of the W2NWA and that part of the NEASWA lying north of U. S. Highway No. 30, all within Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., as another unit. Each of said units will be treated separately.

Claimant's lands in Section 12, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M. were recognized by the Umatilla River Decree under the Courtney Irrigation Company, in the name of C. J. Smith.

The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the land for which a claim is asserted in the proof, number of acres allowed vested and incheate rights in the Umatilla River Decree, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed a completed water right in this proceeding.


It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated a total of 163.4 acres on this unit in completion of the inchoate right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Courtney Canal, with a priority date of 1900, for the irrigation of 163.4 acres of land in Section 12, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M., said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and number of acres as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

Claimant's lands in Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. covering the EANWA and the NEASWA, were recognized by the Umatilla River Decree under the Courtney Irrigation Company in the name of Zoeth Houser. Proof of appropriation filed herein by Glen Male asserts a claim for the irrigation of 34.2 acres in the NW#NE# and 39.4 acres in the SW#NE#, Section 7, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. through the Courtney Canal. Claimant accepts the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

It appears that claimant owns the WhNWhNEt and all of the SWhNEt, said Section 7. The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated on claimant's tract, 17.7 acres in said WhNthEt and 39.4 acres in said SWhNEt.

Claimant's lands were allowed vested and inchoate rights by the Umatilla River Decree under the Courtney Irrigation Company in the name of Henry Baurngardner and E. O. Baumgardner, to the extent of 12.0 acres vested in the Wanwaner, 12.0 acres vested and 28.0 acres inchoate in the Swaner, said Section 7.

It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated 5.7 acres in said  $W_2^1NW_4^1NE_4^1$  and 27.4 acres in said  $SW_1^1NE_4^1$  in completion of the inchoate rights allowed in the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Courtney Canal with a date of priority of 1900, for the irrigation of 5.7 acres in the Wanwanes and 27.4 acres in the Swanes, Section 7, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

### Irvin Mann

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Irvin Mann asserts a claim for the irrigation of 30.9 acres in the NEASWA and 38.5 acres in the SEASWA, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. through the Courtney Canal. Claimant accepts the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

It appears that claimant owns that part of said NE $^1_4$ SW $^1_4$  lying south of U. S. Highway No. 30 and all of said SE $^1_4$ SW $^1_4$ . The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated on claimant's tract 27.9 acres in the NE $^1_4$ SW $^1_4$  and 38.5 acres in the SE $^1_4$ SW $^1_4$ .

Claimant's lands were allowed vested and inchoate rights by the Umatilla River Decree under the Courtney Irrigation Company, in the name of Zoeth Houser to the extent of 7.0 acres vested and 25.5 acres inchoate in said NELSW2 and 40.0 acres vested in said SELSW2.

It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated 20.9 acres in said NEASWA in completion of the incheate right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Courtney Canal, with a date of priority of 1900, for the irrigation of 20.9 acres of land in that part of the NE4SW4, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. lying south of U. S. Highway No. 30.

Claimant has filed herein two proofs of appropriation, one asserting a claim for the irrigation of a total of 162.0 acres of land in the NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>, Section 7, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Courtney Canal, and the other asserting a claim for the irrigation of a total of 133.0 acres of land in the NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>, Section 12, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M., through the Courtney Canal. In both proofs claimant accepts the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land. Since the lands are contiguous, both proofs will be treated as one.

It appears that claimant owns all of said subdivisions except a tract 62 rods north-south by 31 rods east-west, containing 12.0 acres and located in the SE corner of said NWL, Section 7, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

Rogers, asserts a claim for the irrigation of 36.4 acres in the NETWER and 39.4 acres in the SERNER, Section 7, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. under the name of Harle B. Rogers and 16.5 acres in the ERNWANE said Section 7 under the name of Grace B. Rogers.

Claimant, Harle B. Rogers, who signed the proof, did not accept the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land but the acreage in each subdivision for which a right is asserted is as shown on the State Engineer's map.

Claimant's lands were allowed rights by the Umatilla River Decree under the Courtney Irrigation Company as follows: 12.0 acres vested in the NWANE, in the name of Henry Baumgardner, 39.0 acres vested and 1.0 acre inchoate in the NEANE, and 40.0 acres vested in the SEANE, in the name of Grace B. On the basis of a contiguous ownership, claimant is allowed a right to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Crayne-Lisle ditch, with a priority of March 7, 1904 for the irrigation of 11.0 acres described as follows:

2.0 acres in the SEANWA 9.0 acres in the NEASWA Section 36 T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

## Joseph Ramos Estate and Mary Ramos

Claimants are successors to S. I. Lisle, Claude Sloan and John H. Y oung whose lands constitute the balance of the land allowed rights under the Crayne-Lisle Irrigation Company in the Umatilla River Decree, a total of 212.0 acres vested right and 253.0 acres inchoate right, all within Sections 26, 27, 35 and 36, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

Claimants have submitted a Proof of Appropriation wherein a claim is asserted to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Crayne-Lisle ditch for the irrigation of a total of 298.6 acres located in Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 35 and 36, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. Claimants state that they accept the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

Claimant has included the N2SWt, Section 34, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W.M. in the tabulation of lands submitted with their Proof of Appropriation. Said lands are asserted to be served through the "Westland Irrigation Ditch".

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated in the subdivisions for which a claim is asserted in the proof, 39.1 acres in the NEANER, 12.7 acres in the SWANER, 37.6 acres in the SEANER, 32.7 acres in the NWASER, 36.3 acres in the SWASER, 37.6 acres in the SEASER, Section 11, 38.8 acres in the NWANER, 39.4 acres in the NEANWA and 39.5 acres in the NWANWA, Section 14, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

It appears that claimant's east property line is approximately 930 feet west of the east line of Section 16 and the west property line is approximately on the west line of the SELNEL, said Section 17, both adjacent to the irrigated land.

It further appears that, of the 101.5 acres of inchoate water right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree, claimant has beneficially used the waters of Umatilla River in the irrigation of 25.2 acres of land in completion of said inchoate water right.

A right is allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Barnhart Ditch for the irrigation of 25.2 acres of land, with a priority date of 1902, said right being appurtenant to the subdivisions and acreage as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

Relative to the inchoate right for power development allowed in the Umatilla River

Decree under the name of J. E. Smith, Emma E. Smith, successor in interest, it appeared from

an examination of the site of the proposed development that no construction work had ever been

done toward the completion of said right, nor was a claim therefor submitted in this proceeding.

Therefore it is hereby declared that said inchoate water right for power development has been relinquished and forfeited for failure to complete and is of no further force or effect.

#### W. I. McGowan

Claimant is successor in interest to Jas. M. Hemphill, in whose name certain inchoate rights were allowed under the Umatilla River Decree.

In the proof of appropriation submitted by W. I. McGowan, a claim is asserted to the use of the waters of Birch Creek through the Jensen-Jacques-Hemphill Ditch for the irrigation of a total of 34.2 acres of land in completion of the inchoate water right allowed in the Umatilla River Decree under the name of Jas. M. Hemphill, with a date of priority of 1904.

Claimant does not accept the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of all of the irrigated land and has accompanied his claim by a map prepared by W. E. O. Criger, registered engineer, showing 18.0 acres irrigated in the SELSEL, Section 4, T. 1 S., R. 32 E., W.M. as claimed, instead of 6.2 acres as shown on the State Engineer's map.

From a re-examination of the land it appears that the additional acreage for which a claim is asserted in said  $SE_4^1SE_4^2$ , Section 4, has been irrigated as claimed.

The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the lands for which a right is asserted in the proof, number of acres allowed vested and inchoate rights in the Umatilla River Decree, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed herein in completion of said inchoate right.

It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated a total of 34.2 acres of land in completion of said inchoate right, therefore a right is allowed to the use of the waters of Birch Creek, through the Jensen-Jacques-Hemphill Ditch, for the irrigation of 34.2 acres of land, with a priority date of 1904, said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and acreage as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

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### Belle Miller

Claimant is successor in interest to Omer O. Stephens in whose name certain rights were allowed by the Umatilla River Decree, as follows: vested with priority date of 1892, 20.0 acres in the NEANEA, 7.0 acres in the NWANEA and 3.0 acres in the SWANEA, Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., W.M. and inchoate with priority date of 1904 for 7.0 acres in the NEANEA and 20.0 acres in the SEANEA, said Section 26.

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Belle Miller asserts a claim to the use of the waters of McKay Creek for the irrigation of a total of 40.4 acres of land. Claimant states that the State Engineer's map is accepted as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS - UMATILIA RIVER - Page 24

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within the subdivision set out in claimant's proof, 14.0 acres in the NEANEA and 26.4 acres in the SEANEA, Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., W.M. It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated 26.4 acres in the said SEANEA in completion of said inchoate right allowed in the Umatilla River Decres.

On the basis of a farm unit a right is allowed to the use of the waters of McKay Creek for the irrigation of 26.4 acres of land in the SELNEL, Section 26, T. 1 N., R. 32 E., W.M. with a date of priority of 1904.

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#### Pioneer Irrigation Company

Vested rights to the extent of 672.0 acres and inchoate rights to the extent of 328.0 acres, with a priority date of January 9, 1900, were allowed by the Umatilla River Decree under the name of the Pioneer Irrigation Company, said rights being tabulated therein under the names of the individual landowners.

The present owners of the lands served by the distribution system of the Pioneer Irrigation Company have each filed herein an individual Proof of Appropriation and each will be treated separately.

#### Ed Coffman

Proof of appropriation submitted herein by Ernest Dumond in behalf of Ed Coffman, asserts a claim for the irrigation of 17.0 acres in the NW2NW2, Section 5 and 38.6 acres in the NE2NE2, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

Claimant is successor in interest to part of the lands formerly owned by J. A. Mendenhall, in whose name certain rights were allowed claimant's lands, under the Umatilla River Decree as follows: vested rights for 8.0 acres in the NWANWA, said Section 5 and 30.0 acres in the NEANEA, said Section 6, and an inchaate right for 10.0 acres in the said NEANEA.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within said subdivisions, on the lands apparently owned by claimant, 11.8 acres in the NWLNWL, Section 5 and 37.6 acres in the NELNEL said Section 6. It thus appears that claimant is irrigating a total of 49.4 acres, 1.4 acres more than the total allowed vested and inchoate by the decree.

A right is allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Pioneer ditch for the irrigation of 3.8 acres in the NWLNWL, Section 5 and 7.6 acres in the NELNEL, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

### Frank Correa, Sr.

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Frank Correa, Sr. asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 203.4 acres of land in Section 8, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. through the Pioneer Ditch, said land being described as 40.0 acres in the SWLNWL, 27.0 acres in the SELNWL, 38.0 acres in the NELSWL, 37.0 acres in the SELSWL, 33.4 acres in the NWLSEL and 28.0 acres in the SWLSEL. Claimant does not accept the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land, and has accompanied his proof with a sketch map indicating in red crayon, the additional areas claimed as irrigated.

SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS - UMATILIA RIVER - POGG 25

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within claimant's farm unit, 38.2 acres in the SWANWA, 20.8 acres in the SEANWA, 33.7 acres in the NEASWA, 36.0 acres in the SEASWA, 12.0 acres in the NWASEA and 7.5 acres in the SWASEA, said Section 8.

Claimant's sketch map indicates three areas in the SELNWL which are claimed as irrigated in addition to the area shown on the State Engineer's map. A rectangular area of approximately 1.7 acres in the north-half of the subdivision is an orchard on a knoll which appeared too high to irrigate by gravity. An oblong rectangular area of approximately 4.0 acres in the southwest corner of the subdivision was partly the farm building area and partly the barn lot, none of which appeared to have been irrigated. A long, narrow strip lying adjacent to the river channel and south of the orchard tract was definitely not irrigated, being river wash and brush.

Claimant's sketch map indicates an area in the northeast corner of the NELSW. and the northwest corner of the NWLSEL which is claimed as formerly irrigated. This area was river wash and brush land and did not bear any evidence of ever having been beneficially irrigated.

A rectangular area near the southwest corner of the  $NE_4^2SW_4^2$  and the northwest corner of the  $SE_4^1SW_4^2$  was a high, brushy knoll and definitely not irrigated.

From a careful reconsideration of the areas, it appears that the aforementioned orchard tract and farm building area should be classified as irrigated land.

The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the land for which a claim is asserted in the proof, number of acres allowed vested and inchoate rights in the Umatilla River Decree, number of acres claimed in the proof as irrigated, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed a completed right in this proceeding.

It appears that claimant has made beneficial use of the waters of Umatilla River in the irrigation of 18.0 acres of land in completion of the inchoate right allowed in the Umatilla River Decree. A right is allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the pioneer Ditch, for the irrigation of 18.0 acres of land, with a priority date of January 9, 1900. Said right is appurtenant to the subdivisions and acreage as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

### Frank Correa, Jr.

Proof of appropriation submitted by Frank Correa, Jr. asserts a claim for the irrigation of 37.0 acres in the NELNWH and 40.0 acres in the NWENWH, Section 8, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch.

These lands were allowed vested rights by the Umatilla River Decree to the extent of the acreage claimed in the proof, said lands being tabulated in the decree under the name of Frank Correa. Since no inchoate right was allowed, said lands are not involved in this proceeding.

#### Jesa Correa, Jr.

Proof of appropriation submitted by Jess Correa, Jr., asserts a claim for the irrigation of 29.0 acres in that part of the SEASWA, Section 5, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. located south of U. S. Highway No. 30.

The Umatilla River Decree allowed a vested right for 37.0 acres and an inchoate right for 3.0 acres appurtenant to said subdivision, tabulated under the name of A. J. Cleghorn.

A 40 foot county road exists along the west subdivision line and the 100 foot right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 30 traverses said subdivision for a distance of approximately 1350 foot. It thus appears that approximately 3.7 acres of land lies within the road and highway right-of-way, leaving 36.3 acres of irrigated land all of which is covered by the vested right allowed in the Umatilla River Decree, and that the lands in said subdivision are not involved in this proceeding.

### Mrs. Jess Correa. Sr.

Proof of appropriation submitted by Mrs. Jess Correa, Sr., asserts a claim for the irrigation of 38.2 acres in the NW $^1_4$ SW $^1_4$  and 37.4 acres in the SW $^1_4$ SW $^1_4$ , Section 5, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch.

Claimant is successor in interest to B. F. Raley in whose name a vested right for 48.0 acres and an inchoate right for 32.0 acres was allowed by the Umatilla River Decree appurtenant to said subdivisions.

Claimant states that she accepts the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land. The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated 37.2 acres in said NW#SW# and 37.4 acres in said SW#SW#, a total of 74.6 acres.

It appears that claimant has made beneficial use of the waters of Umatilla River for the irrigation of 26.6 acres of land in completion of the inchoate right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree. A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Pioneer Ditch for the irrigation of 6.2 acres in the NWASWA and 20.4 acres in the SWASWA, Section 5, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

## Ernest Dumond

Proof of appropriation submitted by Ernest Dumond asserts a claim for the irrigation of 35.0 acres in the SWANWA and 30.0 acres in the NWASWA, Section 31, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., Amended Decree Yellic pq 4.57 through the Pioneer Ditch.

These lands were allowed vested rights by the Umatilla River Decree to the extent of the acreage claimed in the proof, said lands being tabulated in the decree under the name of W. J. 18 p.  $\mu_{1}^{\mu_{1}}$  Emery and Geo. L. Ward. It appears that these lands are not involved in this proceeding.

### Melva V. Howell

Proof of appropriation submitted by Ernest Dumond in behalf of Melva V. Howell asserts a claim for the irrigation of 1.0 acre of land in the NWASWA, Section 5, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. through the Pioneer Ditch.

Said one acre of land is located in the southwest quarter of said subdivision, between the north right-of-way line of U. S. Highway No. 30 and the Dillon Canal as more particularly described by the metes and bounds legal description submitted with the proof.

Said subdivision was allowed a vested right for 31.0 acres and an inchoate right for 9.0 acres by the Umatilla River Decree, said rights being tabulated therein under the name of B. F. Raley.

It appears that said one acre has been beneficially irrigated in completion of the inchoate right allowed, therefore a right is herein allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Pioneer Ditch for the irrigation of 1.0 acre in the NWLSWL, Section 5, T. 3 No., R. 29 E., W.M., with a date of priority of January 9, 1900. The land to which this right is appurtenant is more particularly described in the tabulation under Finding 27 herein.

#### Clyde Kenison

ver. 259

Claimant has filed herein two proofs of appropriation wherein he has asserted a claim for the irrigation of 26.0 acres in the NELSWL, 25.5 acres in the ElsWLSWL, 37.0 acres in the SELSWL and 7.0 acres in the SWLSEL, Section 31, T. 4 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch, all located south and west of the Umatilla River.

In the Umatilla River Decree under the names of Chas. Kennison, Elmer Reeves and Geo. L. Ward, vested rights were allowed said lands totaling 84.0 acres and inchoate rights totaling 25.0 acres.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated in claimant's portion of said subdivisions, 19.2 acres in the NELSWL, 25.5 acres in the EASWLSWL, 32.6 acres in the SELSWL and 4.7 acres in the SWLSEL. Claimant states that he accepts the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land in the ELSWLSWL, but has submitted a sketch map indicating the location of additional areas which he claims as irrigated in the NELSWL and SELSWL, said Section 31.

Said indicated areas may have been irrigated land many years ago but when classified during 1949 were covered with a dense stand of willow brush and trees and were not beneficially irrigated.

It appears that the irrigated land in the E2SW4SW4, SE4SW4 and SW4SE4, said Section 31 is covered by the vested right allowed in the Umatilla River Decree. It further appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated 5.2 acres in said NE4SW4 in completion of the inchoate right allowed in said decree, therefore, a right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Pioneer Ditch, for the irrigation of 5.2 acres of land in the NE4SW4, Section 31, T. 4 N., R. 29 E., W.M., with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

## Jess Linebaugh

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Jess Linebaugh asserts a claim for the irrigation of 35.6 acres in the Swine, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch.

Claimant is successor in interest to H. Baumgardner under whose name the Umatilla River Decree allowed a vested right for 27.0 acres and an inchoate right for 13.0 acres in said subdivision.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated, 35.6 acres in said SWENE; which claimant accepts as correct, from which it appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated 8.6 acres in completion of the inchoate right allowed in the decree.

SUPPLEMENTAL FINDINGS - UMATILIA RIVER - Page 28

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Pioneer Ditch for the irrigation of 8.6 acres of land in the SWANEA, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

#### Minerva Mendenhall

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Minerva Mendenhall asserts a claim for the irrigation of 20.9 acres in the NE<sub>4</sub>SE<sub>4</sub> and 9.0 acres in the NW<sub>4</sub>SE<sub>4</sub>, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch.

Claimant is successor in interest to J. A. Mendenhall under whose name the Umatilla River Decree allowed a vested right for 15.0 acres in the NELSE, and an inchoate right for 25.0 acres in the NELSE, and 35.0 acres in the NWLSE, said Section 6.

Claimant apparently owns only that part of said subdivisions lying north of U. S. Highway No. 30, upon which the State Engineer's map shows 15.9 acres irrigated in the NEASEA but no irrigated land in the NEASEA. Relative to the land not shown as irrigated, claimant states in her proof,

"This was irrigated before the highway went through. After the highway was established the Oregon State Highway Commission put in under the highway and agreed to put approaches to the land but the commission has not done this as yet and cannot be irrigated until commission so completes."

From a re-examination of the area it appears that the land has been irrigated as claimed in the proof and that, in addition to the 15.0 acres vested right in said NE<sub>4</sub>SE<sub>4</sub>, claimant has completed the inchoate right to the extent of 6.0 acres in said NE<sub>4</sub>SE<sub>4</sub> and 9.0 acres in said NM<sub>4</sub>SE<sub>4</sub>.

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Pioneer Ditch, for the irrigation of 6.0 acres in the NEASER and 9.0 acres in the NWASER, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

## G. J. Newman

Proof of appropriation filed herein by G. J. Newman asserts a claim for the irrigation of 28.0 acres in the NEASWA and 5.0 acres in the SWASEA, Section 5, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch. Claimant is successor in interest, in part, to C. J. Ward under whose name the Umatilla River Dacree allowed a vested right of 20.0 acres in the NEASWA and 14.0 acres in the SWASEA and an inchoate right for 20.0 acres in the NEASWA, said Section 5.

The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated on the portions of said subdivisions lying west of the Umatilla River and apparently owned by claimant, 23.0 acres in said NE<sub>4</sub>SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> but no irrigated land in said SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>. Claimant does not accept the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of all of the land claimed to be irrigated and has accompanied his proof with a sketch map indicating in red crayon the location of the additional area claimed.

The additional area claimed in said NE<sub>+</sub>SW<sub>+</sub>, lying between the border of the area shown as irrigated and the river, lies below the river bank and is river wash covered with willow brush and trees and was not beneficially irrigated. Claimant's land in said SW<sub>+</sub>SE<sub>+</sub> has a vested water right and is not involved in this proceeding.

It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated 3.0 acres in said NEASWA in completion of the inchoate right allowed, therefore a right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Pioneer Ditch for the irrigation of 3.0 acres in the NEASWA, Section 5, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M. with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

## James F. Riley

Proof of appropriation filed herein by James F. Riley asserts a claim for the irrigation of 7.5 acres in the NEASEA, 17.2 acres in the NWASEA, 37.5 acres in the SWASEA and 39.0 acres in the SEASEA, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch. Claimant's lands all lie south of U. S. Highway No. 30.

Claimant is successor in interest, in part, to J. A. Mendenhall in whose name certain rights were allowed under the Umatilla River Decree.

The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the lands for which a claim is asserted in the proof, number of acres allowed a vested and inchoate right in the Umatilla River Decree, number of acres claimed in the proof, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed a water right in this proceeding.

It appears that claimant has beneficially used the waters of Umatilla River for the irrigation of 86.2 acres of land in completion of the inchoate right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River, through the Pioneer Ditch, for the irrigation of 7.5 acres in the NELSEL, 17.2 acres in the NWLSEL, 37.5 acres in the SWLSEL and 24.0 acres in the SELSEL, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

#### Matilda Ruping

Proof of appropriation submitted herein by Ernest Dumond, President of the Pioneer Ditch Company, in behalf of Matilda Ruping, landowner, asserts a claim for the irrigation of 2.0 acres in the SEASEA, Section 31 and 4.0 acres in the SWASWA, Section 32, T. 4 N., R. 29 E., W.M. through the Pioneer Ditch.

It appears that said lands have a vested water right acquired by transfer under the provisions of Section 33, Ch. 283, L. 1923, (now Section 116-606, O.C.L.C.), the State Engineer's order approving said transfer being recorded in State Engineer's Special Order Record, Vol. 1, page 206. It therefore appears that said lands are not involved in this proceeding.

## Ernest R. Sires

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Ernest R. Sires, asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 114.07 acres of land, described as 26.51 acres in the SWNW4, 9.25 acres in the SEASW4, Section 5, 38.56 acres in the NW4NE4 and 39.75 acres in the SEANE4, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., through the Pioneer Ditch.

Of said SELSWA, Section 5, claimant owns that part lying north of the right-of-way of U. S. Highway No. 30. The State Engineer's map shows as irrigated within said subdivisions for which claims are asserted in the proof, 17.8 acres in the SWANWA, 8.2 acres in the SELSWA, said Section 5, 37.5 acres in the NWANEA and 39.2 acres in the SELSWA, said Section 6.

Claimant does not accept the State Engineer's map as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land, and has accompanied his proof with a statement relative to each subdivision and his objections to the State Engineer's map. Each will be treated individually.

## SWLNWL Section 5:

In the Umatilla River Decree under the name of J. A. Mendenhall, this subdivision was allowed a vested right for 7.0 acres and an inchaate right for 20.0 acres. The time limit for the completion of said inchaate right was set by the decree as January 1, 1918, with the provision that said time might be extended by the State Engineer upon proper application therefor. Said time limit was extended, the last extension applied for and granted having expired October 1, 1922. The State Engineer's classification and survey of said land was made during the year 1949 at which time 17.8 acres was classified as irrigated land and the additional acreage claimed in the proof as irrigated, was found to be in brush and timber and not irrigated, nor was there any evidence of it ever having been irrigated.

Claimant asserts that a survey of said subdivision made by the District Soil Conservation

Service Engineer in January, 1951, shows that 26.51 acres was in crop and irrigated. Said assertion
is not disputed however, it appears obvious that the additional area claimed was cleared, placed
in crop and under irrigation subsequent to the survey made under the direction of the State Engineer.

## SELSWL Section 5:

The Umatilla River Decree allowed a vested right for 37.0 acres and an inchoate right for 3.0 acres, appurtenant to said subdivision, under the name of A. J. Cleghorn.

It appears that claimant's tract is all irrigated under said vested right and is not involved in this proceeding.

## NWINE . Section 6:

The Umatilla River Decree allowed a vested right for 36.0 acres and an inchoate right for 4.0 acres appurtenant to this subdivision, tabulated therein under the name of Ed Gnavauch.

Claimant states, "x x x The entire acreage is in crop and under irrigation with the exception of 1.44 acres in public road right-of-way and 1.0 acre of slough and corral as shown on my map.xxx" and asserts a claim for the irrigation of 38.56 acres.

The State Engineer's map shows all of said subdivision as irrigated with the exception of the county road right-of-way along the north and west sides, an area of approximately 1.5 acres. The official government survey of said subdivision shows it to contain 40.0 acres from which it would appear that the irrigated acreage is 38.5 acres instead of 37.5 acres as shown on the State Engineer's map.

### SELNEL Section 6:

The Umatilla River Decree allowed a 40.0 acre vested right appurtenant to this subdivision, under the name of J. A. Mendenhall, and therefor the irrigated land in this subdivision is not involved in this proceeding. It appears that a total of 13.3 acres of land has been beneficially irrigated on claimant's farm unit, in completion of the incheate water right allowed by the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is allowed herein to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Pioneer Ditch, for the irrigation of 10.8 acres in the SWANWA, Section 5 and 2.5 acres in the NWANEA, Section 6, T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M., with a date of priority of January 9, 1900.

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## Stanfield Irrigation District

Proof of appropriation filed herein by the Stanfield Irrigation District, successor in interest to the Furnish Ditch Company, asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 5797.6 acres of land as shown by the State Engineer's map which claimant accepts as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land.

Of said total, 92.6 acres in Section 31 and 12.9 acres in Section 32, T. 4 N., R. 29 E., W.M. are irrigated by water pumped from the Stanfield drain at the approximate center of the NW#SW#, said Section 32.

Claimant is successor in interest to the Western Land and Irrigation Company in whose name the Umatilla River Decree allowed a vested right for 3046.0 acres of land and inchoate rights for 2759.68 acres with priority date of March 14, 1903 and for 11,264.97 acres with priority date of July 1907. The time limit for the completion of said inchoate afpropriations as originally fixed by said decree has been extended from time to time by the State Engineer upon proper application being made therefor, the last extention having expired on October 1, 1945.

Claimant, Westland Irrigation District, has filed herein two proofs of appropriation covering the lands which are claimed to be irrigated in completion of the inchoate appropriations allowed under each date of priority. In each of said proofs, claimant states that the State Engineer's map is accepted as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land, however, in each proof, claimant asserts a claim for a considerably greater number

of acres than are classified as irrigated on the State Engineer's map, and has accompanied said proofs with an explanatory statement and request relative to such additional acreage claimed, part of said statement and request being as follows:

"xxx that in many instances, part of the irrigable land within the ownership unit has been irrigated. That the remaining part of said unit is used to supply pasture which is supplied by seepage.

"That, as a result, the district has been levying assessments for the use of water upon a larger acreage than the maps of the State Engineer show as irrigated.xxxxx

"We, therefore, request that water right certificates be given for these forty-acre tracts in the amount requested, regardless of the fact that there will have to be some future development thereon. In case such a certificate, in the opinion of the State Engineer, cannot be so issued, then we request that the State Engineer issue certificates of water right to the extent he finds in use and then reserve from further appropriation and for future development by the district such amount of water as may be necessary to complete the irrigation of the acreage described herein. XXXX"

It appears that in similar proceedings, after the expiration of the time limit fixed in the court decree, or as extended by orders of the State Engineer, a survey was made of the lands which were allowed inchoate water rights by said decree and a completed appropriation was allowed for only those lands which were found to be irrigated.

In the Umatilla River Decree, the Court stated as follows:

"The State Engineer is hereby directed to issue a certificate to each of said appropriators showing the time fixed by this finding within which the water appropriated by such appropriators shall be applied to beneficial use. The extent of such appropriation shall be limited to such an amount or volume of water as shall have been put to a beneficial use, by the expiration of the time fixed in this finding.xxxx"

As previously stated, the final time for the completion of the inchoate appropriations, expired on October 1, 1945 and the surveys and classification of the lands from which the State Engineer's map was prepared, were made during the year 1949. Each of said proofs submitted by the Westland Irrigation District will be treated separately.

## Priority of March 14, 1903

Proof of appropriation filed herein by the Westland Irrigation District covering the lands allowed an inchoate right under the appropriation of March 14, 1903 asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 3350.6 acres of land through the Westland Canal, called the Hinkle Ditch in the Umatilla River Decree.

The State Engineer's map shows a total of 2533,2 acres irrigated in the subdivisions for which a claim is asserted in the proof. The following tabulation shows the descriptive location of the land, number of acres allowed vested and inchoate rights in the Butter Creek and Umatilla River Decrees, number of acres for which a claim is asserted in the proof, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed a completed right in this proceeding.

It is noted from the above tabulation that of the total area classified by the State Engineer as irrigated, within the subdivisions allowed rights in the Umatilla River Decree in the name of the Western Land and Irrigation Company, 38.2 acres were not claimed in the proof, said acreage being described as follows:

It is also noted from the preceeding tabulation, under Sections 5 and 8, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M. and Sections 28 and 32, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W.M., that certain lands which were apparently found to be irrigated at the time of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Butter Creek and of Umatilla River, were allowed a vested right from each source. From the adjudication maps it appears that approximately the same acreage was classified as irrigated under each determination. Since the priority dates for said lands under the Butter Creek Decree range from 1864 to 1885, all prior to the priority date of March 14, 1903 allowed under the Umatilla River Decree, it appears that, in so far as the acreage is the same, the vested rights allowed under the Umatilla River Decree are supplemental to the Butter Creek rights allowed for the same lands.

Of said lands, it appears that 1.0 acre in the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>5</sub>, O.5 acre in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 5 and 2.0 acres in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 8, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M., should properly be allowed a right herein supplemental to the vested rights allowed under the Butter Creek Decree, however, since the total of 3.5 acres is such a small amount, said lands will be included herein under the primary rights allowed in completion of the inchoate appropriation of the Westland Irrigation District.

It thus appears that of the total of 3350.6 acres of land for which a claim is asserted in the proof, claimant has beneficially irrigated a total of 1364.9 acres in completion of the incheate appropriation of March 14, 1903, allowed in the Umatilla River Decree.

A right is herein allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the Westland Canal with a priority date of March 14, 1903, for the irrigation of 1364.9 acres of land, said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and number of acres as set out in the last column of the preceding tabulation.

### Priority of July 1907

Proof of appropriation filed herein by the Westland Irrigation District covering the lands allowed an inchoate right under the appropriation of July 1907, asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 6659.1 acres of land through the Westland Canal.

The State Engineer's map shows a total of 3504.1 acres irrigated in the subdivisions for which a claim is asserted in the proof. The following tabulation shows the descriptive

location of the land, number of acres allowed vested and inchoate rights in the Umatilla River Decree, number of acres classified by the State Engineer as irrigated and number of acres allowed a completed right in this proceeding.

A right is herein allowed to the use of the waters of Umatilla River through the  $\frac{1}{2} \frac{1}{2} \frac{1}{2} \frac{1}{2}$ . Westland Canal with a priority date of July 1907, for the irrigation of 2539.6 acres of land, said right to be appurtenant to the subdivisions and number of acres as set out in the last column of the preceeding tabulation.

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### Lester Murray

Proof of appropriation filed herein by Lester Murray asserts a claim for the irrigation of a total of 197.1 acres of land as shown to be irrigated on the State Engineer's map which claimant accepts as correctly showing the location and area of the irrigated land. Claimant asserts that said lands are served through the ditch of the Western Land and Irrigation Co., now called the Westland Canal.

All of the land for which a right is asserted in this proof, except 1.0 acre in the NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub>, 0.3 acre in the SE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> and 0.2 acre in the SW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup><sub>4</sub> said Section 13, was included in the proof of the Westland Irrigation District and treated under Finding 25 herein.

It appears that claimant has beneficially irrigated the above mentioned total of 1.5 acres in connection with his other lands, that said land was inadvertently over-looked in the preparation of the Westland Irrigation District proof, and that claimant is entitled to a water right for said land.

A right is herein allowed for the irrigation of 1.0 acre in the NW: NEt, 0.3 acre in the SEt NEt and 0.2 acre in the SWt NWt, Section 13, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M., through the Westland Canal, with a date of priority of March 14, 1903, equal to the adjoining lands under the Westland Irrigation District.

Now at this time the above-entitled matter coming before the Court for entry of Decree upon the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer as to the extent to which the inchoate water rights allowed by this Court in its Decree dated the 9th day of September, 1916, have been perfected in accordance with the Oregon Water Rights Act, and this Court having heretofore on January 3, 1961, heard the arguments of counsel and the testimony of the exceptors and objectors to said Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, being now fully advised in the premises and having entered its Oral Opinion on the 16th day of February, 1961;

IT IS CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- (a) That the exceptions and objections of all claimants, be, and they hereby are denied, except as hereinafter allowed.
- (b) That the proceedings of the State Engineer in this matter, be, and the same hereby are approved as hereinafter amended.
- (c) That the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, as filed in this Court on the 15th day of December, 1953, are hereby made the Findings and Order of Determination of this Court, subject however, to the following modifications:

1

That, relative to the petition and objection filed by A. J. Vey, Trustee of the Estate of Joseph Ramos, deceased, the State Engineer has filed with this Court a statement as to the validity of said petition and has recommended to the Court that certain additional acreage, which was classified as irrigated land on the State Engineer's adjudication map, but which was inadvertently omitted on the objector's statement and proof of claim filed in this proceeding, be allowed a water right. The Court having reviewed said petition and statement of the State Engineer relative thereto, finds that said certain lands which were not allowed in the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, have, and are being irrigated in completion of the inchoate water right allowed by this Court, in accordance with the tabulation of acreage as set out in the State Engineer's

statement relative to objector's petition, and there being no objections thereto, it is hereby ordered that the right of the Estate of Joseph Ramos and Mary Ramos, as set out in the tabulation of rights allowed, appearing on page 53 of the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, be, and the same hereby is amended and modified to include the lands as set out in the following tabulation:

Relative to the petition of Frank Correa, Sr. the Court finds that, in addition to the acreage allowed by the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, as set out in the tabulation of acreage appearing on page 55, opposite the name of Frank Correa, Sr., under the right of the Pioneer Irrigation Company of Stanfield, Oregon, an additional 8.0 acres have been irrigated, being 4.0 acres in the NELST and 4.0 acres in the NELST and 4.0 acres in the NELST. Section 8. T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M.

Now therefore it is hereby ordered that the award in the name of the Pioneer Irrigation Company appearing on Page 3, be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Relative to the petition of the Westland Irrigation District, the Court finds that said petition, in general, should be, and the same hereby is in all particulars, denied. The Court further finds that, from the testimony and evidence adduced herein, certain individual landowners under said District are entitled to an allowance of acreage awarded a water right in addition to that set out in the tabulation of acreage in the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, appearing on pages 60 to 64, inclusive, thereof, as follows:

Relative to the testimony of Maurice Hall, owner of the SEASWA of Section 32, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M., who asserted that he irrigates a total of 20.0 acres of land within said sub-division, it appears that the State Engineer classified only 9.0 acres as irrigated, all lying southeast of the ditch which is shown on the State Engineer's map as traversing said sub-division in a northeasterly direction.

In the tabulation of acreage under the Westland Irrigation District, said 9.0 acres was not tabulated for the reason that the original Umatilla River Decree of September 9, 1916, allowed a vested right for 10.0 acres appurtenant to said SEASWA, Section 32, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

From the testimony adduced, the Court finds that an additional 9.0 acres should be allowed appurtenant to said SELSW1, Section 32. It therefore, is ordered that the allowance within Section 32, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M., appearing on page 64 of the tabulation of irrigated acreage, be, and the same hereby is amended and modified by the addition of 9.0 acres within the SELSW1, said Section, so that the tabulation as amended shall read as follows:

9.0 acres in the SELSWI 29.6 acres in the SWISE 22.8 acres in the SELSEL Section 32 T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

Relative to the testimony of Charles McKenzie, owner of the SEASWA, Section 33, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M., who asserted that he irrigated a total of 15.0 acres within said subdivision instead of the 4.5 acres as shown by the State Engineer's survey and as set out in the tabulation of acreage appearing on page 64 thereof, the Court finds that an additional 10.5 acres should be awarded within said subdivision, in accordance with the testimony adduced.

It therefore is ordered that the tabulation of acreage irrigated appurtenant to Section 33, T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M., appearing on page 64 of the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, be, and the same hereby is amended and modified so as to read as follows:



11.0 acres in the NE4SW4 15.0 acres in the SE4SW4 Section 33 T. 5 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

Relative to the testimony of Robert B. Dickenson, owner of the SELSEL, Section 8, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W.M., lying west of the Umatilla River, who asserted that he has irrigated 25.0 acres within said sub-division whereas the State Engineer's has made no allowance appurtenant to said sub-division, the Court finds that, from the testimony adduced, an allowance of 25.0 acres, appurtenant to said sub-division should be made. It therefore is ordered that the tabulation of acreage irrigated appurtenant to Section 8, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W.M., appearing on page 63 of the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, be, and the same hereby is amended and modified by the addition of

25.0 acres in the SEASEA

immediately following the

acreage there tabulated appurtenant to Section 8, T. 4 N., R. 28 E., W.M.

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It is further ordered that the total acreage of the Westland Errigation District of July 1907 priority, appearing on page 62 of the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination, be, and the same hereby is increased by the addition of the above increased awards of 52.5 acres, from 2539.6 acres to 2592.1 acres.

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That, upon request of the State Engineer for the correction of certain typographical errors appearing in the Findings of Fact and Order of Determination, which were detected and called to the attention of the Court prior to the hearing before the Court, the Court having considered the matter, finds that the requested corrections are valid and should be made, it therefore is ordered that the following corrections of typographical errors, be, and the same hereby are made:

- (a) On page 53, under Finding No. 15 in the name of the Dillon Errigation

  Company, Stanfield, Oregon, "T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M." shall be inserted in the next

  line immediately below "Section 1" so that the acreage there tabulated shall appear
  as appurtenant to Section 1, T. 3 N., R. 28 E., W.M.
  - (b) On page 27 under the name of Ernest Dumond, "T. 3 N., R. 29 E., W.M." appearing in the second line of the first paragraph, shall be corrected to read "T. 4 N., R. 29 E., W.M."

IT IS FURTHER CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED: that, in accordance with said Findings of Fact and Order of Determination of the State Engineer, as

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modified and amended herein, the various claimants are entitled to the use of the waters of Umatilla River and its tributaries as contained in these findings and this Decree, and they, and their successors and assigns, and all persons, firms and corporations claiming under them, are hereby enjoined and prohibited from using any of the waters of said stream system in any other amount, manner and priorities than herein found, nor upon any lands or place of use other than herein set out and described without first having complied with the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.550 inclusive, or statutory legislation supplementary thereto.
